The Course

Albarella Sea Links the course born from the sea and shaped by the wind. The style of classic British courses and the charm of the Venetian Lagoon. Designed by British architect John Dering Harris, the course covers 70 hectares on an **18-hole** course characterized by water and sand obstacles with dunes, lakes and wild olive trees.

This **sea-links** develops in unique surroundings in which players are joined by very special playing companions, the fallow deer, who have found their oasis of tranquility here. To create this golfer's paradise, more than two million cubic metres of sand were extracted from the sea in 1972, which is why it is known as 'The Course Born from the Sea'.

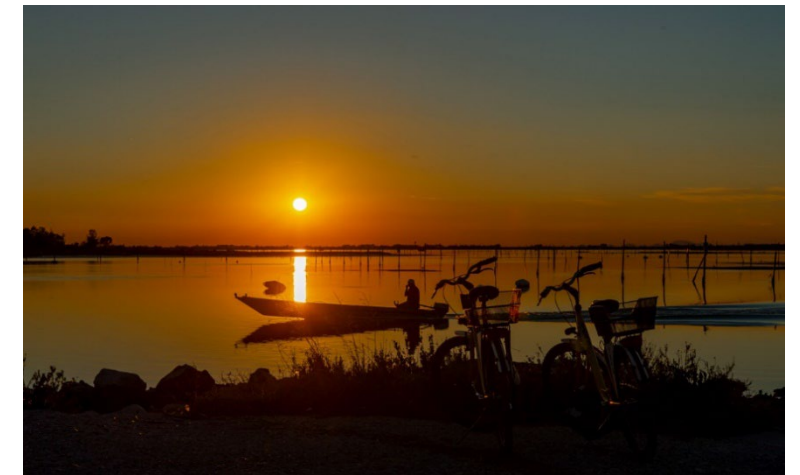
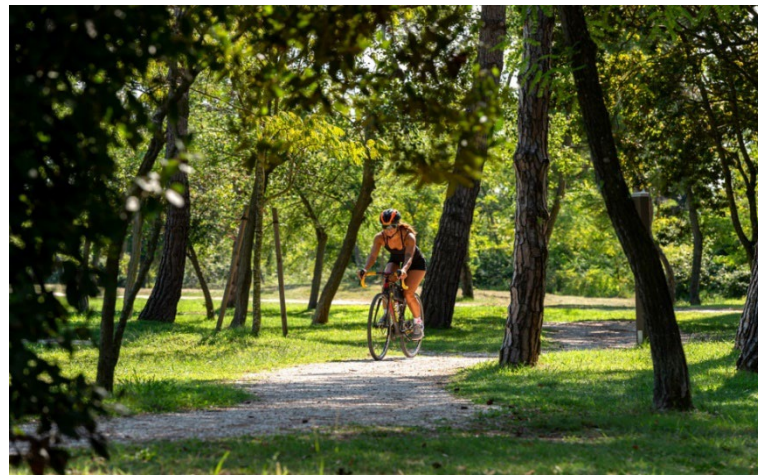

Sustainability

Green areas occupy **70%** of Albarella's surface area. Since 2017, Albarella Island has been developing the 'Immersed in Nature' project designed by the Paris-based atelier Coloco, which envisages a series of interventions to upgrade the island's natural and environmental heritage.

The island is a treasure trove of **biodiversity** populated by more than 60 species of birds, more than 10 species of mammals, more than 200 plant species and a specialized population of fungi and bacteria with different requirements.

We reduce plastic consumption. Our studies have shown that in the ecosystems of Albarella and Porto Caleri there is a **10 times lower** concentration of plastic than in the surrounding areas.

The island's drinking water supply is taken from the Adige River in an autonomous manner and the wastewater is treated in a **modern membrane purifier** and used for irrigation purposes on the golf course and green areas to reduce consumption. The water is **100% recycled**.

Albarella is following a path to become the first island in Italy able to guarantee a **zero** impact on CO2 emissions. The project called '**Albarella Futuro - Zero Carbon Emission**' was developed by the University of Padua to plan a set of actions aimed at achieving a zero balance between carbon created and consumed.
